PROFILE

Mater Dei CMI College belongs to the CMI congregation whose founder St. Kuriakose Elias Chavara was declared as a Saint in the Catholic Church on November 2014 in Rome. It is a self-financing Arts & Science Regular College affiliated to the University of Kerala, run by dedicated CMI fathers, managed by the CMI Santhi Bhavan, Province of St. Joseph, Thiruvananthapuram. The College is located at Enathu on the banks of Kallada river, between Adoor & Kottarakkara. The College is situated in a campus extending to 13 acres, hosts a multi storied building with all modern infrastructure to provide excellence in education.

CMI EDUCATION HISTORY

The tradition of CMI (Carmelites of Mary Immaculate) educational history is more than one and a half century old. The contributions of this first indigenous religious congregation in the educational development of Kerala were pioneering and revolutionary. In the year 1846, Saint Kuriakose Elias Chavara (1805-71), its founder, started the first school at Mannanam, near Kottayam (the first cent percent literate town in India) and admitted students of all castes and creeds. Realizing the importance of education, he, in his capacity as the Vicar General of the Syro-Malabar Church, ordered all its parish churches in 1864 to start schools attached to all the churches. Hence, school was known in the vernacular as "Pallikkoodam". This historic order triggered the emergence of a galaxy of educational institutions all over the state. To facilitate education, he started the first catholic press at Mannanam in 1846 and printed so many books, especially devotional books. The first Catholic Malayalam daily "Nazrani Deepika" (known as Deepika now) also started printing from this press in 1887. The revolutionary initiatives of Saint Kuriakose Elias may be the basis of the higher literacy rate and advanced position of Kerala, which was declared the first 100% literate state in India.

EXTENDING SERVICES TO ENATHU

As a witness to the CMI penetration into remote rural areas and to provide excellence in education, Fr. Jose Kadavil CMI came to Enathu on the M.C.Roadside and started a school in 1990 for the Deaf and provided them English education with residential facilities. To cater to the local needs we started Mount Carmel CMI Central school under CBSE scheme in 2012 and the Mater Dei CMI College affiliated to the University of Kerala in 2014 as the CMI contribution for national development and to translate our commitment and inspiration.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

DRESS CODE

As part of the total discipline at the campus, dress code has been prescribed for all students. Pants, Full sleeve shirt and half sleeve over coat of specified colour, black belt and black shoes with black/blue socks.

CLASS TIMINGS

Class timings from 9.30 AM to 3.30 PM on all days except Saturdays and Sundays. List of other holidays will be displayed on the College Notice board. The local holidays declared by collector or management due to strike, bandh, natural calamities etc may be compensated as a working day on the following Saturday.

ATTENDANCE

University regulations in the matter of attendance will be strictly enforced.

NORMS OF BEHAVIOUR

- Strict discipline is enforced right from day one at the college campus.
- Students are not permitted to leave the campus during class hours without a written request of the parent.
- Use of mobile phones and electronic gadgets may be permitted on a written request recommended by the parent.
- Medium of communication in the campus is English.
- Students are to greet all the staff members and respectable persons seen in the campus.
- Students are not expected to enter any other classroom even during intervals.
- Any postal articles for students reaching the college will be opened by the Principal and distributed as per his discretion.
- No one shall distribute any notice among the students or staff nor invite anyone to college without the prior permission of the principal.
- Any meeting, picnic or any kind of organised group activity can be arranged only with a written permission of the Principal.
- The College is a WI-FI campus. Students are expected to use it only for educational purpose.
- Any type of ragging is prohibited by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- Any written complaint by any student in this regard will be seriously dealt with.
- Any complaint of students shall be directly informed to the Principal first.

IDENTITY CARD

All students will be issued identity cards which they should wear all the time they are in the campus. Non wearing of identity card and uniform will attract suitable punishment.

COLLEGE ELECTION

Our college is declared as a politically neutral campus as per the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court. Students shall not indulge in any political activity or canvassing. Any type of political activities are not permitted either during college election time or on any other occasions. External political interference is not permitted in our campus for maintaining a peaceful and studious atmosphere.

LIBRARY

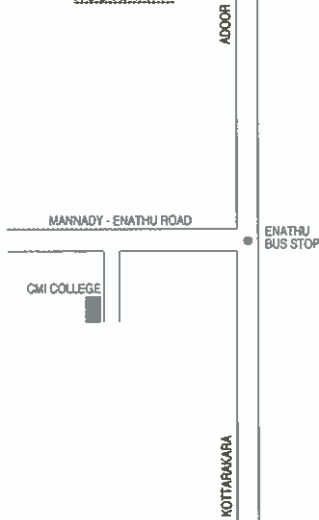
College Library is open for students during office hours. Two books shall be issued in one's name at a time and shall be returned within 15 days.
